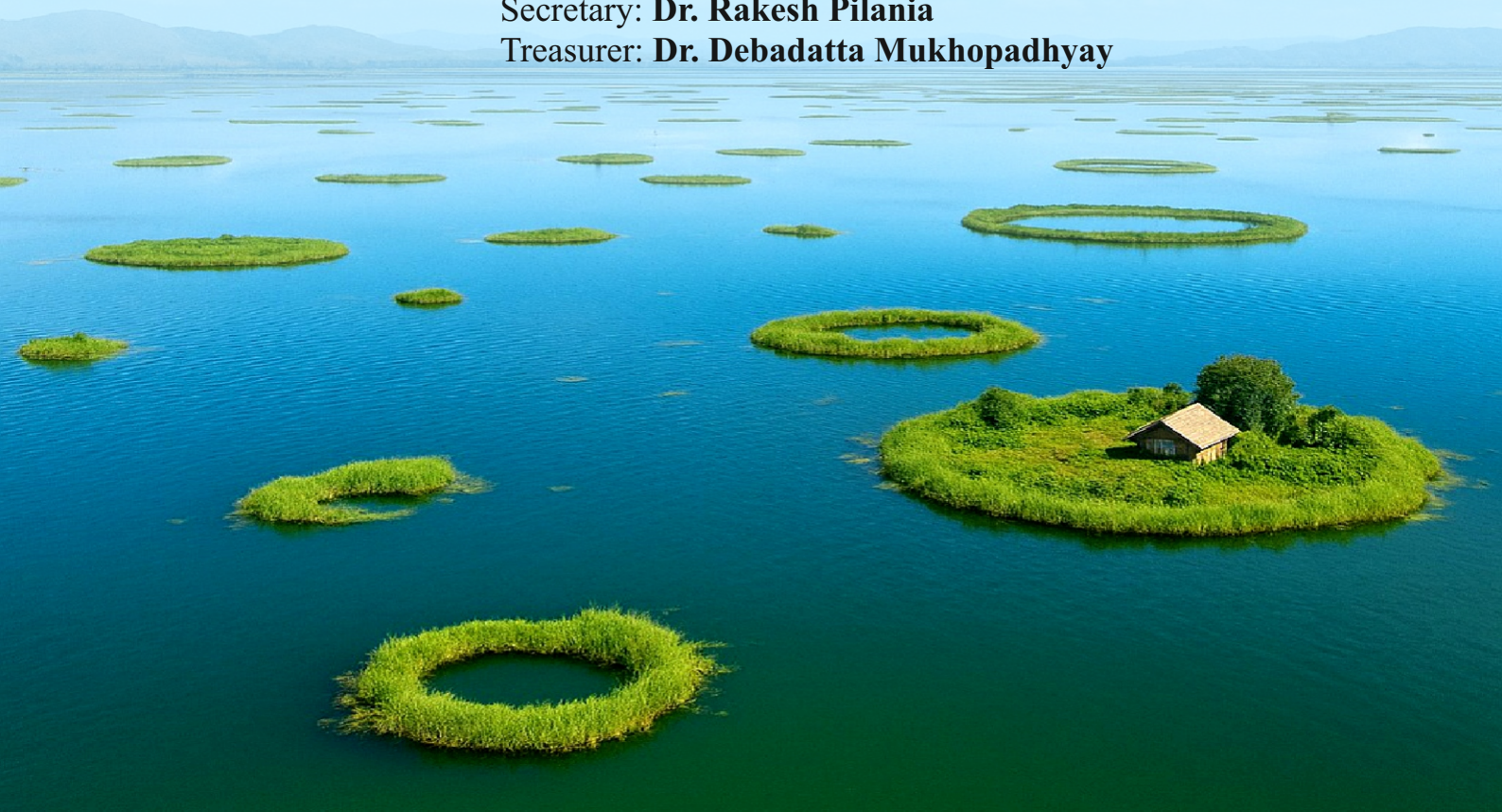

Abstract Submission Timeline

The abstract submission deadline is **5th August, 2026**. Notifications will be sent on **7th August, 2026**.

Abstracts Eligible for Submission

* Abstracts describing original research on basic and clinical science related to Kawasaki disease should only be submitted.

Abstracts Not Eligible for Submission

* An abstract is ineligible for consideration if it reports work that has been published as a manuscript (e.g., full-length article, brief report, case report, concise communication or letter to the editor, etc.) prior to the submission deadline of **5th August, 2026**.

* Multiple abstracts may not be submitted for one study unless substantially different research questions are being addressed in each abstract.

Abstract Withdrawal

Prior to notification of acceptance:

Presenting authors may submit a request to have an abstract withdrawn till **6th August, 2026**. All requests for withdrawal can only be made by the presenting author and must be submitted via email to: iskdconference2026@gmail.com.

Abstract Submission Instructions/Guidelines

Submitting an Abstract

- * All abstracts must be submitted online only.
- * Conference registration is mandatory.

Abstract Character Limit

- * **Title** character limit: 300 characters, excluding spaces.
- * All authors should be listed under the title, along with their designation and institution
- * **Body** character limit: 3000 characters, which excludes the title, names of authors/co-authors, authors' affiliations, spacing, and disclosures.
- * **Image, table, and/or graphics:** There is a limit of three image, table, and/or graphic per submission. The tables and/or graphics do not count towards the character limit.
- * References in the abstract body will be included in the character count.
- * Original research should be structured as:
Introduction/Aims/Methods/Results/Conclusion
- * The case report should be structured as: Introduction/ Case/Conclusion.
